VISITOR INFORMATION

Welcome to Grace-Atlanta Bible Church! We are a grace-oriented church where all believers are welcome to fellowship in God's infallible Word, and grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

CHURCH SERVICES – We believe the Bible clearly reveals that the purpose of the local church is to teach Christians how to live the spiritual life that they have been given in Christ, in order to fulfill God's will for their lives (Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 2:42; Col. 1:28; 2 Tm. 3:16-17; Eph. 2:10; 4:12-15). This is why all church services are successive Bible classes where the pastor is responsible to shepherd the flock by preaching God's Word. (Jn. 21:15-17; 2 Tm. 4:2; 1 Pet. 5:2). Over the course of his ministry, the pastor should cover the entire Bible from Genesis to Revelation (Acts 20:27; 2 Tim. 3:17). This equips the Christian to do the work of the ministry, and bring the Gospel to the unsaved (Eph. 4:12; 2 Cor. 5:20)

MUSIC – Our worship format is traditional, singing the great hymns of the Faith (we do not conduct “contemporary” music-based worship services), as everything must be done properly and in an orderly manner (Jn. 4:24; 1 Cor. 14:40; Eph. 5:18-21).

GIVING - The plate is not passed and funds are never solicited. For those who are motivated to give, offering boxes are located at the exits of the church sanctuary, and in the foyer. This is a testimony of our faith in God to work in His children to will and to do (2 Cor. 9:7; Phil. 2:13).

BIBLE CLASS SCHEDULE –

Sunday – 1st class – 10:00 – 11:00 AM

Break – 11:00 AM – 11:30 AM (Coffee provided in the fellowship hall)

2nd class – 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM (The 2nd class is a continuation of the 1st hour's class).

Wednesday – 7:30 – 8:30PM

COMMUNION SERVICE - Church membership is not required, as Communion is open to all believers in the Lord Jesus Christ. Communion is normally held the 3rd Sunday of every month during the second hour.

NURSERY - Nursery is available on Sundays during both services.

SUNDAY SCHOOL - Children ages 4 -8, and children ages 9-12 will attend Bible Class with their parents during the first hour, and then transfer to the Primary and Junior Sunday School classes respectively. Children over twelve attend both services with their parents in the main sanctuary. This system facilitates interaction between parents and children over what has been taught. .

DEACONS – The church deacons are responsible for the administrative affairs of the church, and are available to answer any questions that you might have. Ask any member to direct you to a deacon for assistance.

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP – Church membership is strictly voluntary, and is not required except in regard to serving as a deacon (males only), and congregational voting privileges.
